E) Coordination

6. PES Institute of Advanced Management Studies, Shivamogga, Karnataka and Kumadvathi First Grade College, Shikaripura, Karnataka shall name a coordinating committee consisting of teaching/research staff and (a) Principal of PES Institute of Advanced Management Studies, Shivamogga, Karnataka or his/her nominee, (b) Principal of Kumadvathi First Grade College, Shikaripura, Karnataka or his/her nominee, (c) Coordinator from PES Institute of Advanced Management Studies, Shivamogga, Karnataka and (d) Coordinator from Kumadvathi First Grade College, Shikaripura, Karnataka, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

F) Activities for Immediate Future

7. Both the Institutions will meet to discuss and finalize on conducting and organizing joint special invited talks', workshops, seminars, symposia and innovative activities by students.
8. A team of faculty research staff from PES Institute of Advanced Management Studies, Shivamogga, Karnataka and Kumadvathi First Grade College, Shikaripura, Karnataka, will make it a priority to visit each other's Institute for a short duration to discuss and

interact for the purpose of conducting workshops, seminars, conferences and for the development of mutual Diploma Certificate Courses and research collaborations.

9. A select group of students from both institutions will visit the collaborating institutions to study possible research areas, or to conduct research activity or academic pursuit.

G) Terms and Termination

10. This MOU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for the period of **five years**, and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement.
11. This MOU may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by one of the parties upon prior notice to the other in writing not later than six months before the termination date. Once terminated, neither PES Institute of Advanced Management Studies, Shivamogga, Karnataka a nor Kumadvathi First Grade College, Shikaripura, Karnataka, will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, PES Institute of Advanced Management Studies, Shivamogga, Karnataka and Kumadvathi First Grade College, Shikaripura, Karnataka, will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.
12. Any cooperation under this MOU is subject to the availability of funding sources.

17. The parties may disclose certain confidential information to the other in relation to any future proposal made under this MOU. Non-disclosure agreements will be made for each such event between the individuals involved from both institutions.

 - b. 25% on total fee to be paid after completion of 200 hours of the programme.
 - c. Balance 25% on total fee to be paid after completion of the programme of 428 hours.
4. The cost of providing any extra or associated service to students will be charged by the Training Company directly to the students.
