Report on Micro Teaching 2021-22 (Even Semester)

Micro teaching based on various skills was held from 18th July 2022 to 27th July 2022. As a Student trainee, students got the skill of using black board. Micro Teaching:

Micro teaching is a scaled down sample of teaching in which a Student trainee teaches a small unit to a various classes for a period. Micro teaching is defined as "a scaled down teaching encounter in class size and class time"

Objectives of micro teaching:

- 1. To enables student–trainees to learn and assimilate new teaching skills under controlled conditions.
- 2. To enable student trainees to gain confidence in teaching and to master a number of skills by dealing with a small group of pupils.

Description

- 1. It is called scaled down teaching
- 2. It is less complex than regular teaching.
- 3. Its duration is short about 15-20 minutes per student trainee.

Teaching skill is a set of related overt behaviors of the teacher which are observable, definable, measurable, demonstratable and refinable through practice. These skills are known as core teaching skills.

- 1. Skill of introducing a lesson.
- 2. Skill of explaining
- 3. Skill of using black board
- 4. Skill of questioning
- 5. Skill of stimulus variation
- 6. Skill of illustrating with examples.
- 7. Skill of prohibing questions
- 8. Skill of reinforcing
