RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT POLICY

1. Preamble

PES Institute of Technology and Management (PESITM) is committed to fostering a vibrant research culture that promotes innovation, knowledge creation, and technological advancement. The institution recognizes research as an integral component of higher education and strives to create an ecosystem that encourages faculty members, researchers, and students to undertake high-quality, ethical, and socially relevant research.

This policy provides a comprehensive framework for planning, promoting, monitoring, and evaluating research activities in accordance with the University Grants Commission (UGC) and VTU Guidelines for the Establishment of Research and Development Cells (RDCs), National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, and other applicable regulatory provisions.

2. Vision

To develop PES Institute of Technology and Management into a nationally recognized research-driven institution with global collaborations, fostering excellence in interdisciplinary research, innovation, entrepreneurship, and sustainable technological development through the Research and Development Cell.

3. Mission

- Promote applied and translational research addressing societal and industrial needs.
- Provide state-of-the-art research infrastructure for faculty, research scholars, and students.
- Encourage interdisciplinary research in engineering, science, and emerging technologies.
- Contribute to sustainable engineering solutions in renewable energy, biomedical engineering, autonomous systems, artificial intelligence, nanotechnology, sensor networks, advanced materials, and quantum computing.
- Foster collaborations with industries, research organizations, universities, and international institutions.

4. Objectives

The objectives of the Research and Development Policy are to:

6. Enhance consultancy and technology transfer activities.
7. Promote innovation and entrepreneurship among students and faculty.
8. Ensure ethical conduct of research through established institutional mechanisms.
9. Improve the institution's research rankings, visibility, and societal impact.

6. Seed Money Scheme

The PES Institute of Technology and Management Seed Money Scheme provides financial support for approved innovative research projects to promote a strong research culture, facilitate proof-of-concept studies, foster interdisciplinary research, and encourage the acquisition of external research funding, publications, patents, and technology transfer.

The objectives are to:

- Support pilot research projects.
- Facilitate submission of externally funded proposals.
- Encourage interdisciplinary research.
- Promote patent-oriented research.

Projects shall be evaluated based on novelty, feasibility, societal relevance, expected outcomes, and budget requirements.

7. Research Incentive Policy

The institution shall provide incentives for:

- Publications in Scopus/Web of Science indexed journals.
- High SNIP/SJR journal publications.
- Books and book chapters published by reputed publishers.
- Sponsored research projects.
- Patent filing and granted patents.
- Consultancy projects.
- Technology transfer and commercialization.
- National and international research awards.

The incentive structure shall be notified separately by the Research and Development Cell.



8. Sponsored Research

Faculty members shall be encouraged to obtain funding from:

Government Funding Agencies: University Grants Commission (UGC), Department of Science and Technology (DST), Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO), Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO), Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR), Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR), Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), Ministry of Education (MoE), Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE), AICTE, VTU and other Central and State Government agencies.

Reputed Academic and Research Institutions: Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs), Indian Institute of Science (IISc), National Institutes of Technology (NITs), Central Universities, State Universities, and other recognized national and international higher education and research institutions.

Industry and Corporate Organizations: Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs), private industries, multinational corporations, research and development organizations, start-ups, and industry associations through sponsored research, consultancy, and Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiatives.

International Funding Agencies: World Bank, Asian Development Bank (ADB), United Nations agencies, UNESCO, UNICEF, the European Union (EU), Horizon Europe, the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, the Wellcome Trust, and other recognized international funding organizations, subject to Government of India regulations.

The institution shall:

14. VTU Requirements for Research Centres



For departments seeking recognition as VTU Research Centres, the institution shall ensure compliance with the applicable VTU Research Regulations, including:

- Availability of VTU-recognized Research Supervisors in the concerned discipline, as prescribed by the University.
- Provision of adequate laboratory, computing, research, and library infrastructure to facilitate high-quality doctoral research.
- Subscription to the prescribed national and international journals, along with access to relevant digital library resources.
- Maintenance of the required faculty strength, qualifications, and faculty–research scholar ratio in compliance with VTU norms.
- Adherence to all VTU regulations, including inspection, monitoring, reporting, and other requirements for the recognition, continuation, and renewal of the Research Centre.
