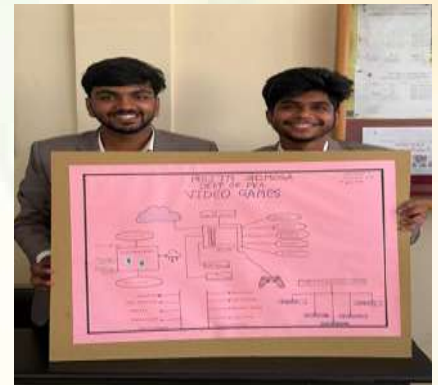
POSTER PRESENTATION

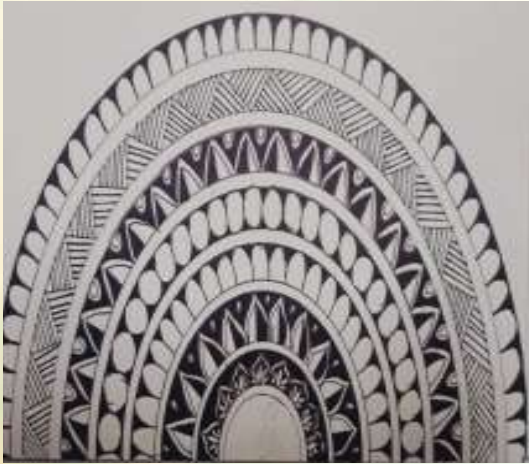
