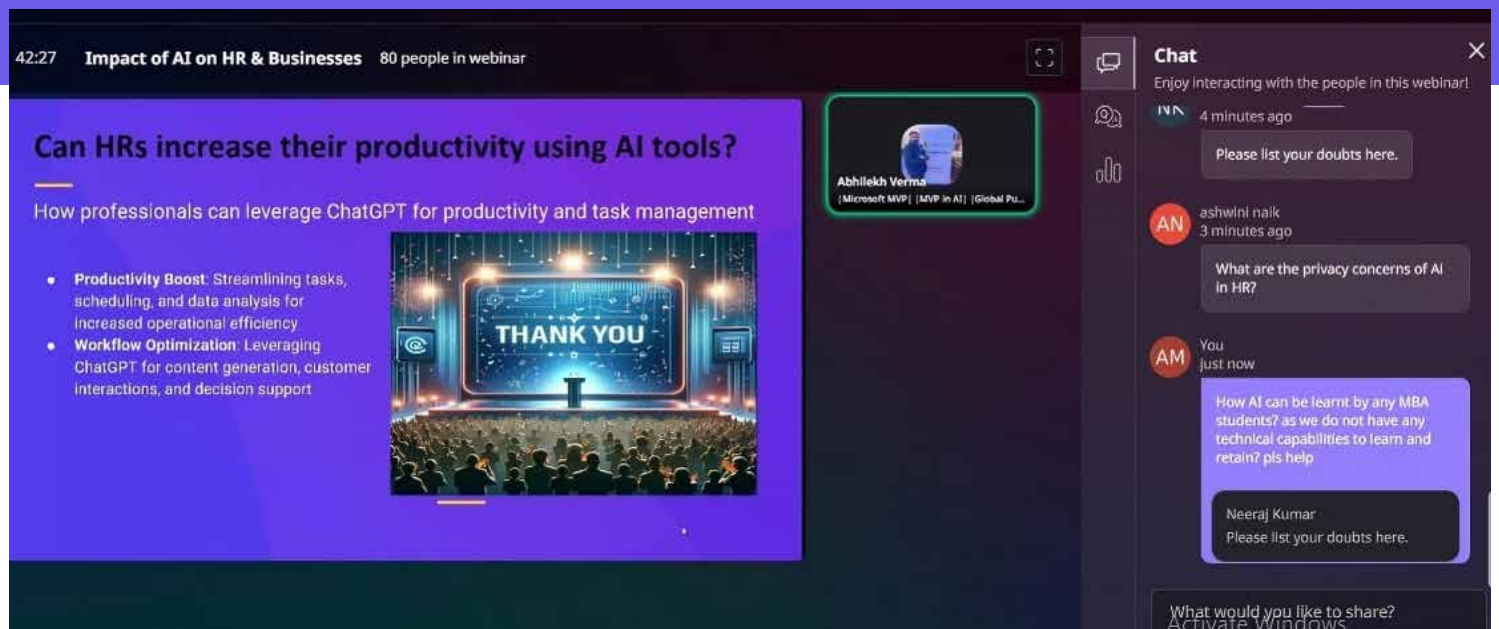
## Seminar on "Publication in the Current System"

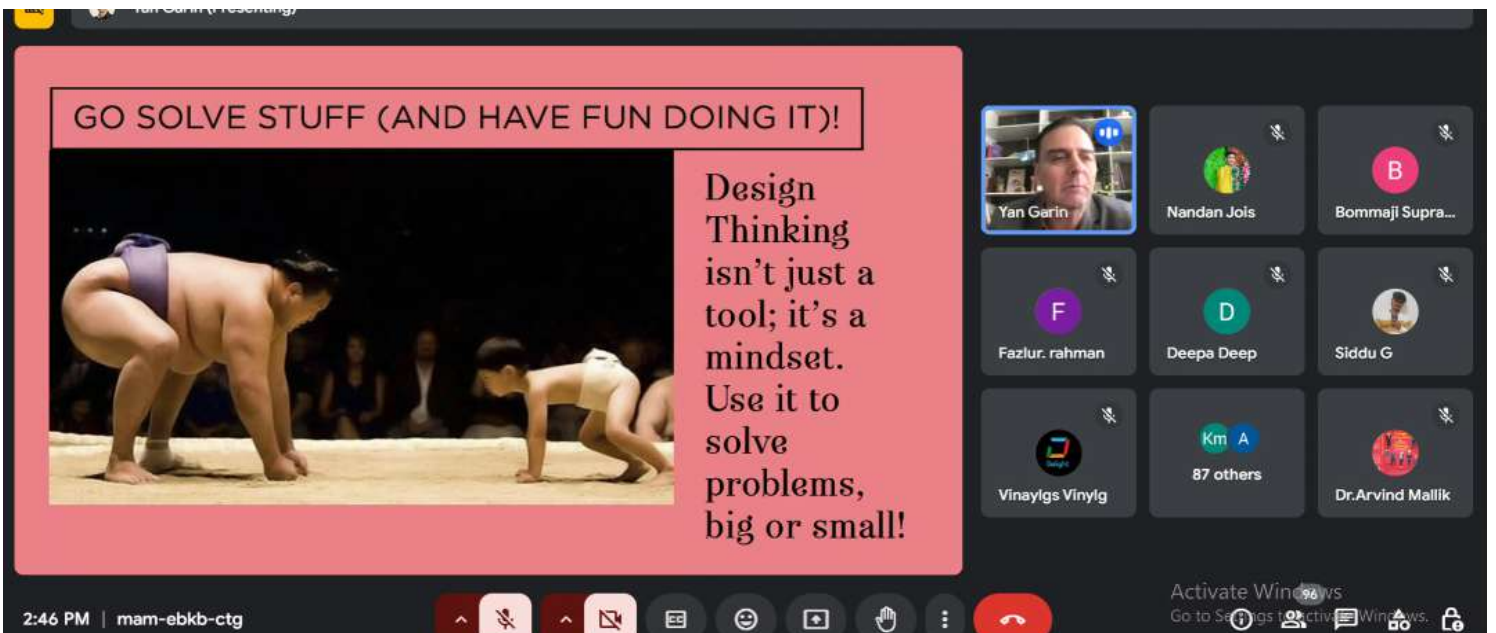
## Session on Campus to Corporate

## Anvesana boosting growth of small startups in Shivamogga: Raghavendra

ANVESANA, a non-profit organisation formed in July 2023 to create entrepreneurial culture in small towns, is helping small startups of the districts promoting entrepreneurship among youths, said Chairman of Anvesana and MP B Y Raghavendra.

He told reporters here on Friday that Anvesana was set up with the vision of making Shivamogga a hub for innovation and entrepreneurship. Anvesana has been selected under the TBI 2.0 - LEAP Program of the IT BT Ministry, Government of Karnataka, with a Rs 10 crore grant (with an additional 20% of this, state of the art labs will be established in PES Campus in the city. AI and ML, IoT, Robotics, Mechanical, AR/VR, and 3D Printing Labs. These labs will provide early-stage startups with critical infrastructure to design, prototype and test products locally. The goal is to support 100+ startups in the next two-three years, with a focus on AgriTech, tourism, healthcare, and EdTech domain startups, he added.

Managing Director of Anvesana, C M Patil said that Yuva Shristi is a flagship programme under Anvesana, that has focused on nurturing entrepreneurship thinking among young minds, with 200+ student innovators on board the programme. Over 9,000+ students have been exposed to entrepreneurship, 50+ teams working on proof of concepts and over 200 workshops and sessions were conducted.

Vridhi is a flagship programme under Anvesana that is designed for aspiring entrepreneurs ready to launch their ideas. Over 30 startups were supported with over 20 active industry mentors, 14 startups have raised Rs 12 crores and above funding, creating more than 100 jobs through these supported startups, he informed.

He said that Anvesana is organising a 'Startup Leadership Talk' on PES College Campus in the city on September 13 at 4 pm. From the project, more than 9,000 students have been exposed to entrepreneurship, he added.

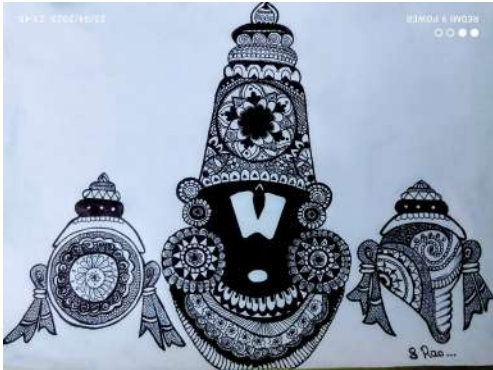

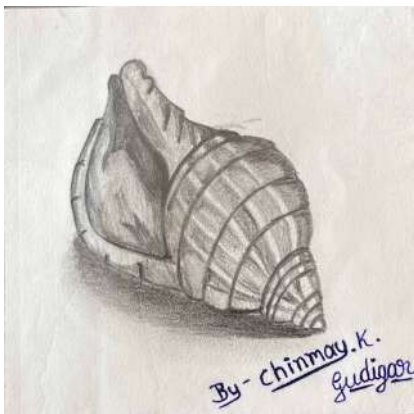

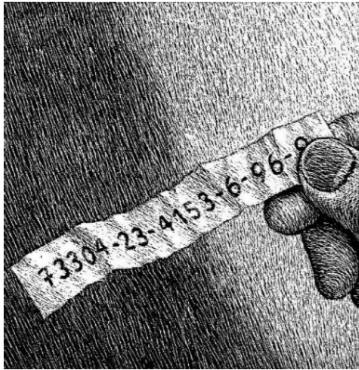
## The Numbers: That Never End
