
Best Kudo Athlete Award



Students Activities

Visit to the Market


Art Activity by Leaves

The Grade 4 students exhibited their art by using leaves to showcase different plants that have different types of leaves. By creating art forms like cat, rangoli, butterfly and some floral designs.

Math Activity

The students of Grade 3 learnt math with available materials like buttons, dice and colour papers. The students learnt multiplication, addition, subtraction and division using these things very easily. Practical learning is the best way of learning maths which holds a permanent impression in their little minds.





Air Pollution

Students learnt the causes of Air Pollution through beautiful charts and models and how to avoid air pollution.



Decorating the Republic Day

The decoration of the Republic Day Celebration was done by Grade 8 students as part of Art Integration with fluttering colours of ribbons, balloons and our National Flag Wave.

Terrarium

The students practised this activity at their homes with a lot of care and observed the growth of plants and their movements. By using a glass container containing soil and plants in an environment different from the surroundings. It is usually a sealable container that can be opened for maintenance or to access the plants inside.

The students got trained with many Asanas, Pranayamas and Surya Namaskara for a healthy body, soul and mind.



Rewarding Kids with Medals & Trophies

The students were honoured with certificates and medals and trophies for performing well in activities like co-curricular activities (CCA), Sports and academics. A great way to acknowledge their effort and reinforce positive behaviours is where a strong emphasis is often placed on education and achievements. The purpose of the activity is to consider the potential impact of rewards on intrinsic motivation and the importance of balancing external and internal motivation.



Students Activities

Incubation of Eggs

The students of Grade 5 thoroughly observed the everyday process of incubation and learnt how the process inside the eggs happens. For chicken eggs it involves maintaining specific conditions to facilitate embryonic development and hatching. This process typically takes 21 days and requires an incubator to control temperature, humidity and egg turning. The optimal temperature range is 37.5 - 39 degree C.



Human Skeleton

Grade 5 students visited the Biology lab to watch and learn about the human skeleton and they were able to understand the parts of the human skeleton system and types of joints. The students learnt that humans have 206 bones of which 126 are part of the appendicular skeleton, 74 are part of the axial skeleton, and six are part of the auditory ossicles.



Rain Gauge and Wind Vane

The activity focused on Grade 3 and 4 learning, recording weather reports by using a wind vane and a rain gauge. The students experienced how the wind vane and the rain gauge work. This activity increases their observation skill and their scientific temper.



Students Activities

Cooking without Fuel

The Grade 6 students prepared mouth-watering dishes and were presented elegantly by giving importance to hygiene and cleanliness. The main attraction of the day was the variety of healthy dishes like salads of pulses, fruits, veggies, etc.



Digestive System Activity

The students of Grade 7 learnt about the model of the digestive system and the process of the system. The students could gain more knowledge about the digestive system.

Best out of Waste

The students of Grade 8 participated in creatively reusing discarded materials to create new, useful or artistic items and hosted the best out of waste exhibition cum sale on the products which they prepared and exhibited gloriously. This typically highlights the purpose, participation, learning outcomes and environmental impact of such events that emphasize the importance of resourcefulness and environmental awareness.


