Gross Motor Skills

The Gross Motor Skills activity is focused on large muscle movements of the arms, legs, and whole body. It is very important for children's physical growth and coordination.



Art and Craft Activities



Art and craft activities boost children's creativity and imagination. They improve fine motor skills, focus, and self-expression while making learning fun. Such activities build confidence and encourage kids to explore their ideas in colorful ways. Our little artists explored their creativity through fun and colorful art & Craft activities. With tiny hands and big imaginations, the children created beautiful masterpieces using paper, glue, paints, and a variety of craft materials. The Origami Activity is an activity with the coloured paper that improves eye-hand coordination, enhances concentration and patience, and encourages creativity in PHE/ Fine Motor Skills.



Memory Test

We conducted a Memory Test activity for the kids. The children observed the objects carefully and tried to recall the names of the objects. This activity helped them improve their concentration and memory skills. All the students participated with great enthusiasm, and it was a fun learning experience for our kids.



STEM Activities

In STEM learning, the children get to enjoy exciting hands-on activities. The students learn Colour Magic, observing how colours mix and change. Besides this, the student learns about life skills like Seed Germination, watching how a tiny seed sprouts into a plant. Shadow, drying up the things with sunlight, different types of circles drawn with the help of lids. The students also learned about different types of leaves, their shapes, sizes, and patterns. These activities helped the children learn through fun, observation, and exploration.



Assembly Time

Assembly Time is a fun and learning time for our children as they come together to say prayers, share a thought for the day, say a science fact, and learn English to advanced English. Our children speak with confidence and enjoyed being on stage. The Assembly helps them learn new things and become better speakers.
